BIHAR - EXIT/POST POLL AE 2025 - HIGHLIGHTS

1. Pro-Incumbency on account of good and clean governance clubbed with fatigue Chief Minister Nitish Kumar Rule of almost 2 decades.
2. युवा खासकर 18 - 39 उम्र (50% टोटल मतदाता) वर्ग बदलाव चाहता है। परन्तु दूसरा 50% वर्ग महिलाओं का बड़ी संख्या में 'नीतीश-मोदी' के समर्थन में वोट कर रहा है।
3. मुख्यमंत्री रोजगार योजना के तहत 1.40 Crore+ महिलाओं को दिये गये ₹10,000/- NDA के लिये निर्णायक साबित हो रहे हैं।
4. दोनों गठबंधन में जातिगत आधार पर NDA का पलड़ा भारी नजर आ रहा है। महागठबंधन मुस्लिम-यादव और रविदास दलित वर्ग को छोड़कर अन्य सभी जाति वर्ग में पीछे है।
मुस्लिम+यादव वर्ग का लगभग 32% मतदाता है इन दोनों वर्ग का करीब 80-90% वोट एक मुश्त महागठबंधन को मिलने के कारण चुनाव को अधिक रोचक बना दिया।
5. Axis My India पोल में 95% chance है कि NDA आसानी से सरकार बना लेगा, परन्तु 5% Chance है कि 1-2 सीट कम रहने की संभावना है। इसका प्रमुख कारण ऐतिहासिक Voter Turnout % है।
18 - 39 उम्र वर्ग के 50% मतदाता है और अमूमन ये वर्ग तुलनात्मक दृष्टिकोण से कम वोट करता है, परंतु इस बार 67% वोटिंग में इस वर्ग ने भी बड़ी संख्या में मतदान किया है।

6. प्रशांत किशोर की JSP पार्टी को लगभग 4% वोट मिलता दिख रहा है और जोकीहार विधानसभा सीट पर सरफराज आलम की अपनी लोकप्रियता से JSP का खाता खुलने की उम्मीद की जा सकती है।
परंतु चुनाव अभियान पिछले 3 साल को देखकर कहा जा सकता है, "प्रशांत किशोर की कोशिश काबिले तारीफ है, परंतु मंजिल अभी दूर है।"
7. JSP को मिल रहे 4% वोट में 75% NDA का और 12% MGB तथा 13% अन्य से आ रहा है।
8. प्रशांत किशोर का 3% Points एवं VIP पार्टी का 2% Points अर्थात् टोटल 5% Points के असर को LJP ने NDA के साथ गठबंधन करके महागठबंधन को होने वाले फायदे (Edge) को काफी हल्का कर दिया है। (पिछले विधानसभा चुनाव में LJP ने अलग चुनाव लड़के 6% हासिल किये थे।)
